Application deadlines

fall: July 1
spring: November 1

Integrated courses that blend several disciplines within a theme, and education courses that complement the science and mathematics content of the program, will emphasize the interrelationships that exist between topics within mathematics and science across the K-12 curriculum.

Admission requirements

- A minimum of a 2.5 undergraduate GPA
- Praxis or GRE scores
- Transcripts of all undergraduate and graduate coursework
- A statement of goals
- Two letters of recommendation
- Valid teaching certificate, if applicable
- TOEFL scores (if the primary language is not English)
